









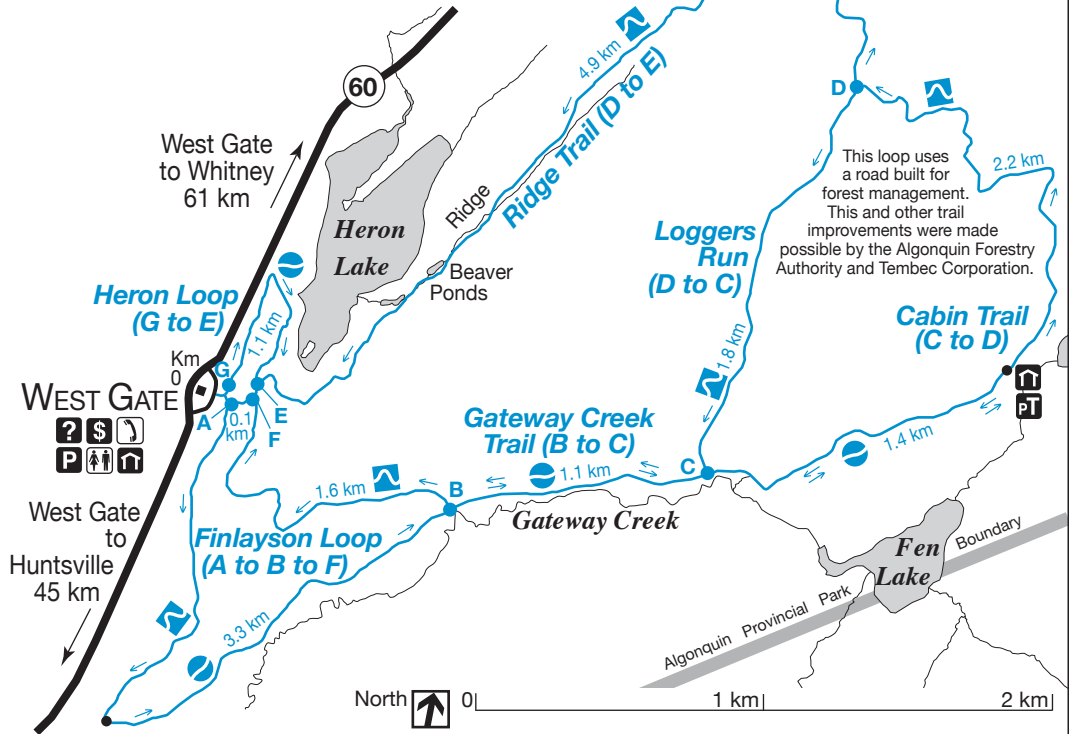


Fen Lake Ski Trail

Much of the Fen Lake Ski Trail travels through hardwood forest, typical of Algonquin's west side – with Sugar Maple, Yellow Birch, American Beech, and Eastern Hemlock being the most prominent species. You will almost certainly see the tracks of moose or deer on your outing, deep holes in the snow which occasionally pose problems for our trail groomers.
