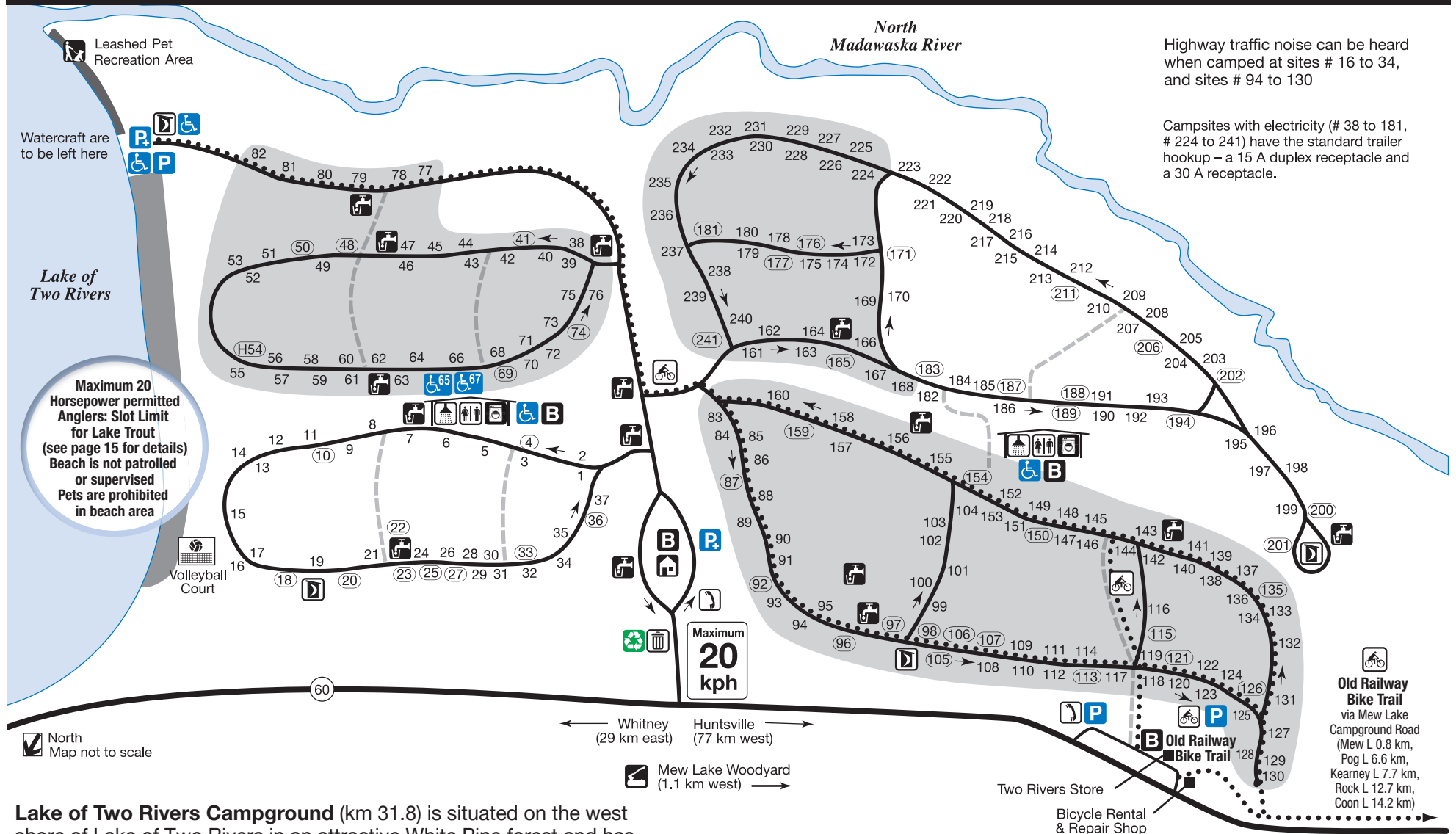


Lake of Two Rivers Campground



Lake of Two Rivers Campground (km 31.8) is situated on the west shore of Lake of Two Rivers in an attractive White Pine forest and has an excellent beach. This campground is the oldest and best known of Algonquin's campgrounds.

Open: May 15 to October 13, 2014

Operated by: Algonquin Park Services under contract with Ontario Parks; and volunteer Hosts can assist with Park information

Firewood: for sale at the Mew Lake Woodyard (travel West on Highway 60 for 1.1 kilometres to Woodyard)

Services:

- 241 sites, electrical sites, wheelchair accessible sites
- flush toilets, laundry, showers
- access to the Old Railway Bike Trail via Mew Lake Campground (see map)
- adjacent to the Two Rivers Store
- 20 horsepower motors allowed on Lake of Two Rivers
- Weatheradio at FM 100.1
